I invite you to join me on a pilgrimage to Italy on May 20-30, 2024. Joining us on the trip will be Fr. Bill Cremers and his group from St. Patrick Church in Fremont, NE. Fr. Cremers is a native son of St. Anthony parish and school and he is also a graduate of Scotus Central Catholic High School.

The title of the pilgrimage is: The Saints of Italy Pilgrimage

We will start the pilgrimage by spending five full days in



Rome. We will then head to San Giovanni Rotondo, Italy for two days to visit the Shrine of St. Padre Pio. We will also visit a nearby shrine where St. Michael the Archangel appeared in the year 490 A.D. to the local bishop. Every year thousands of pilgrims visit this Shrine, which is called The Sanctuary of St. Michael
