The St. Ann group will meet Monday, March 4 at 7 p.m. in the Parish Center. All ladies of the parish are invited!

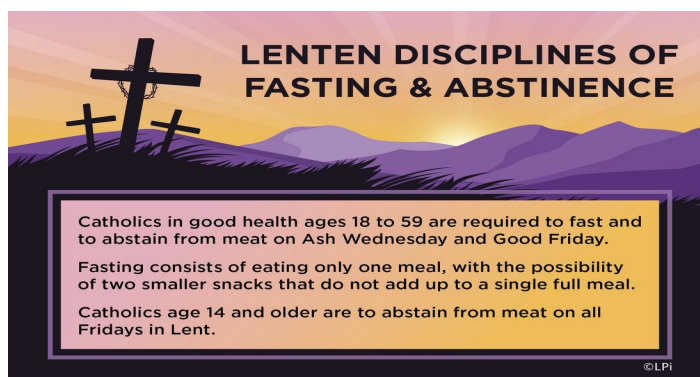
WELCOME NEW MEMBERS
