From the Pastor ...

Happy New Year to everyone. We have had quite the start with all the snow and cold. I hope you are all doing well.

I will be taking some time off this coming week and weekend (Jan. 27/28) and return to my office and pastoral duties on Tuesday January 30, 2024.

The Holy Land pilgrimage that I was scheduled to lead this coming May 2024 was canceled several weeks ago due to the



ongoing war in Israel. Let us pray for peace in the Holy Land. However, I have been invited by the same company to lead an alternative pilgrimage to Italy covering the same dates as the original Holy Land Pilgrimage, i.e., May 20-30, 2024. An added bonus is that we will be joining Fr. Bill Cremers and his group from St.

Patrick Church in Fremont, NE. Fr. Cremers is a native son of St. Anthony parish and school and he is also a graduate of Scotus Central Catholic High School.

The title of the pilgrimage is: The Saints of Italy Pilgrimage

We will start the pilgrimage by spending five full days in Rome. We will then head to San Giovanni Rotondo, Italy for two days to visit the Shrine of St. Padre Pio. We will also visit a nearby shrine where St. Michael the Archangel appeared in the year 490 A.D. to the local bishop. Every year thousands of pilgrims visit this Shrine, which is called The Sanctuary of St. Michael the Archangel. We will then visit a church in Lanciano, Italy which is the place of arguably the most well-known Eucharistic miracle in the history of the Catholic Church. We will also visit Loreto, Italy which is where the House of the Blessed Virgin Mary was miraculously transported by angels from Nazareth to Italy in the 13th Century. Finally, we will spend two days in Assisi, Italy, the home of Saint Francis and Saint Clare of Assisi.
